Why to write a manifesto? and how can we contribute to this field?

Critical interface manifesto

- I interface, you interface, we interface.
- An Interface is not a neutral space. Ideologies are always embeded in the interface, but those are not always visible.
- The success of interface is defined not only by its ability to generate the interaction, but to have the user to understand how this interaction occurs and the set of rules that determines the interaction.
- As a tool the interface should provide the acknowledge of its own shape and limits.
- Freedom of use implies knowledge and to be consequent.
- Interfaces can also be honest and simple.
- You can claim the right to know and understand without having to really know about each interface.
- Design is emotional, functional and political. Interfaces are designed.
- Interfaces can be potentially everything, objects, movements, behaviors, spaces, sounds...
